

Common Sense

English Enjoying Stories: Bear and Chook



Students will explore stories with a focus on how language is used to entertain. They will sequence events from stories and

retell the story in their own words.

InitialLit

Students will be engaged in daily literacy blocks that incorporate phonemic awareness, decoding and spelling activities using children's literature. They will learn about written words, rhyme, oral language and letter recognition. They will identify letter names and sounds of the alphabet.

Quick Writes and Handwriting

Students will experiment with writing through daily quick write/ quick draw activities and practice uppercase and lowercase letter formations.

Maths Students will be learning to:

- Compare the length and thickness of objects
- Continue repeating patterns
- Describe 2D shapes
- Construct 3D shapes
- Recall forwards and backwards sequences
- Connect number names and quantities up to 20
- Count forwards and backwards from different starting points
- Explore movement and directions
- Use questions to collect data

Computational Fluency

Students are explicitly taught how to connect names, numerals and quantities. They use material to model problems and participate in games and number talk using these strategies.
