

Mo Willems students will explore letter writing and create a short imaginative letter responding to a character from a picture book. They

will include an illustration to match their letter.

InitialLit

Students will be engaged in daily literacy blocks that incorporate phonemic awareness, decoding and spelling activities using children's literature. They will learn about written words, rhyme, oral language and letter recognition. They will identify letter names and sounds of the alphabet.

Quick Writes and Handwriting

Students will experiment with writing through daily quick write/ quick draw activities and practice uppercase and lowercase letter formations.
