Under this agreement for 2021
Baringa State Primary School will receive

\$390,000*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students receiving C or above in Reading & Writing to 90%
- Increase the percentage of students receiving A or B in Reading to 50%
- Improve student performance in NAPLAN to statistically above the nation for Mean Scale Score (MSS) and Upper Two Bands (U2B's) for Reading
- Improve student performance in NAPLAN to statistically above the nation for MSS for Spelling & Writing
- Explicitly track Computational Fluency P-6 for improvement (Number)

Our initiatives include


- An evidenced based approach to teaching reading - "The Big 6" Balanced Reading Program
- Reading mentors building the consistent capacity of teachers in reading instruction
- An evidenced based approach to teaching writing and tracking using data walls
- P-2 consistent approach to teaching phonics and phonemic awareness, with early intervention
- Years 3-6 consistent approach to teaching, Tier 2 and academic vocabulary
- Evidenced based approach to Direct Teaching of Spelling (P-6)
- Adopting a Number Sense Approach of explicit teaching instruction to improve fluency of number facts

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Intentional Collaboration – Teaching planning cycles (\$82,400) + Inclusion teachers (\$4,700)	\$87,100
• Differentiation in teaching, extra teacher aides in Reading rotations Yrs 1-6 (55 hrs week)	\$100,800
• Differentiation in teaching & learning by implementing Reading Mentors in Yrs 1-6: Resources	\$10,000
• Professional Development (PD) in research-based Number & assessment for learning (PC)	\$15,000
• PD & mentoring of Signature Practices to have a consistent approach (New Teachers)	\$6,440
• PD of pedagogical practices in Spelling Mastery to have a consistent approach	\$3,000
• "At Risk" students: Employ additional teacher aides to implement MiniLit (20 hrs week)	\$37,004
• Increase Speech Language Support 0.4 (0.2)	\$24,600
• Teacher Aide 8th Prep contribution	\$32,000
• Engagement Officer \$78,000 budget (\$39,000)	\$39,000
• Teacher Aide enhancements Year 1 & 2	\$35,056
