Under this agreement for 2022
Baringa State Primary School will receive

\$430,766*

This funding will be used to

- 90% of students Prep - Year 6 (P-6) receiving C or above in Reading & Writing
- 50% of students P-6 receiving A or B in Reading
- Statistically above the nation in NAPLAN for Mean Scale Score (MSS) & Upper Two Band results for students in Years 3 and 5 (Reading)
- Statistically above the nation (MSS) for students in Years 3 and 5 (Spelling & Writing)
- Support student engagement and wellness to participate in learning

Our initiatives include

- An evidenced based approach to teaching reading – “The Big 6” Balanced Reading Program
- Reading Mentors building the consistent capacity of teachers in reading instruction
- An evidenced based approach to teaching writing and tracking using data walls
- P-2 consistent approach to teaching phonics and phonemic awareness, with early intervention
- Providing strategies for teaching and learning that enable teachers to increase engagement of students with complex, unmet learning needs and to successfully improve *all* students’: self-regulation, relationships, wellbeing growth and academic achievement.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Supporting intentional collaboration – teaching planning cycles (\$82,400) & Inclusion teachers (\$4700)	\$87,100
• Providing differentiation in teaching, extra teacher aides in Reading rotations Years 1-6 [55 hrs week]	\$100,800
• Providing differentiation in teaching & learning by implementing Reading Mentors - Teacher release for co-teaching	\$10,000
• Supporting “At Risk” students: intervention programs for phonological awareness and letter/ sound relationships (phonics) - employing additional teacher aides to implement–MiniLit	\$38,000
• Year 1 intervention / prevention project trial Semester 1: 2x4 classes shared 2 hours/day 5 days a week (9:00-11:00 & 11:45- 1:45) – Challenge the “Dip”	\$38,000
• Providing a Student Engagement Teacher 0.8	\$110,925
• Providing a Student Engagement - Behaviour Teacher Aide additional (flexible)	\$23,941
• Providing a STEM teacher (0.8 FTE) 0.2	\$22,000
